The law related to computer crime is changing very quickly. **3 Modern** criminals are using computers to help them commit **crimes like identity theft** and to make it easier to commit **old crimes like theft or fraud**. One issue that makes it hard to fight computer crime is that this type of offence is often more difficult to solve than traditional crimes because the criminals are invisible and their actions may be hard to prove. Another issue is that it is quite difficult to **4prosecute** a computer criminal successfully **1because usually nothing is actually stolen or physically damaged**.

In recent years computer crime has increased as the number of people using the Internet to buy things or to access their bank accounts has grown. This new type of business has attracted **2 techno-criminals** who **order goods without paying, or break into the computer systems of businesses and move money to their own account or send viruses which can seriously damage computers and the information they contain**. These viruses can affect millions of people worldwide.

Criminals can use the Internet to plan crimes and pass on **5confidential** information more easily than meetings or telephone conversations. Computers allow criminals access to millions of people whom they may persuade to pay for something worthless.
